## New York City USBC Mary Ann Walton Seniorettes Tournament Rules

- 1. All games in this tournament are governed by USBC Rules and Regulations.
- 2. Tournament is USBC certified. Tournament has no age divisions
- 3. Tournament is open to all NYCUSBC female members 50 years and older as of March 11, 2017.
- You do not have to be a member of a senior league.
- 4. Bowlers must have a 2016-2017 NYCUSBC membership. A Local membership may be purchased for \$10 if you had a NYCUSBC average last year and are bowling elsewhere this year. If not bowling currently, but had a
- 5. NYCUSBC average from the previous year an associate membership may be purchased for \$21.
- 6. All Prizes: Doubles, Singles, All-Events (Singles and Doubles scores combined) will be **Handicap Only.** Re-entries permitted but you may cash only once in the singles and once with each partner in the doubles.
- 7. Handicap will be 90% of the difference between the bowlers average and 240. Bowlers over 240 will bowl scratch.
- 8. Reserved spots for prepaid entries only. Walk-ins will have lanes assigned in sequence.
- 9. Prize ratio: At least 1 in 6. Prize fee returned 100%

10. Bowlers first entry in singles and first entry in doubles will count for all-events. Fee must be paid before throwing your first ball in the tournament.

- 11. Entering Average:
  - a. Highest NYCUSBC certified book average (21 games or more) for the 2015-2016 season. (NYCUSBC Jurisdictional averages only)
  - b. Bowlers with no NYCUSBC 2015-2016 certified average may use their current average (21 games or more) as of March 4, 2017
  - c. March 4th Standing sheet required NYCUSBC Jurisdictional averages only!
  - d. Bowlers with no NYCUSBC certified book average must enter at 240.
  - e. The 10 Pin rule is waived for all bowlers as is rule 319E
  - f. USBC Rule 319d (reporting of prize winnings) does not apply.
- 11. All averages will be verified and corrected by NYCUSBC according to the above stated rules prior to issuing prize checks..

12. Any bowler who has at any time, been re-rated by any tournament, association or league, must inform the Tournament Management of such re-rate in writing before bowling in this tournament.

- 13. All winners must provide verification of their age.
- 14. Closing date for entries will be March 19, 2017 at 3:45 PM.
- 15. All decisions of the tournament management are final unless appeal is made in accordance with USBC Rule 329.
- 16. Maximum number of bowlers on a pair will be six (6).
- 17. Entry fee will not be refunded. Entries close 30 minutes before squad time.
- 18. All squads to start on time. If not on lanes when practice starts (does not mean waiting in line to register) bowlers may bowl in following squad.
